



**CITIOLOG SECURES NEW FUNDING FROM EXISTING SHAREHOLDERS AND ALSO ADDS TO, STRENGTHENS ITS MANAGEMENT TEAM**

*Company to Use New Funds To Increase Worldwide Marketing and Sales Activities for its Advanced Video-Based Traffic, Transportation And Security Solutions*

**PARIS, France – November 27, 2007** – Citilog, a world leading provider of intelligent real time video monitoring and surveillance solutions for traffic, transportation, security and safety management, today announced it secured 1.3 million Euros in additional funding from existing shareholders. The company will use the funding to increase worldwide marketing and sales efforts of its advanced real time incident detection systems for the intelligent transportation systems (ITS), security and safety markets. In addition, the company has hired new key management executives to further expedite its efforts.

The funding was provided by CDC Innovation (subsidiary of major French banking group Caisse des Dépôts) and TECHFUND Capital Europe. The management team additions, which were finalized a few months ago, include Joint CEO Christian Girardeau. Girardeau brings with him strong experience developing various IT companies. Citilog also appointed Dr. Harold Worrall (former Chairman of IBTTA-International Bridge, Tunnel and Turnpike Association) as its new Chairman of the Board.

The funding and management changes have already provided noticeable results in key markets such as Asia where a worldwide distribution network of technically trained partners has been established to meet specific needs of Asian-based customers. In addition, Citilog has secured several new deployed applications that include automatic incident detection at the M30 ring road around Madrid in Spain (650 cameras) as well as the tunnels on the A86 highway in the Parisian region (600 signals in real time).

In November, the French Interior Minister publicly reiterated a desire to triple the amount of video surveillance systems in two years. Today 340,000 surveillance cameras are operating in France and this growing market aims at reaching one million units, representing a strong opportunity for Citilog. Many French municipalities of all sizes expressed willingness to equip themselves with this type of system as soon as possible.

“Citilog has also established a strong presence in the smart urban surveillance market resulting from successes in its road sector products,” commented Girardeau. “Thanks to this new capital increase and a now stronger management team, Citilog aims at exceeding five million Euro turnover and achieve strong and consistent long term growth.”
